USAGE

Reconstitute in 100mM NaHCO₃, 500mM NaCl (pH7.3) or ddH₂O to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. Do not vortex. EDTA is not allowed in reconstituted solution, and the protein is most stable in NaHCO₃ (pH7.3).


STORAGE

Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8°C for one month. Aliquot and store at -80°C for 12 months.

STABILITY

The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37°C for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
